

Fix Annoying Blue Light Switches

If you are like us and find the glaring blue laser bright switch lights way too much at night... the fix is quite easy. Many people report covering the switch with tape, covering them with clothing, etc. But the solution is much easier and more permanent.

First, gently pop out the center of the switch from the housing as shown in this photo. A small flat head screwdriver works well to pop these out. Just look closely at the photo to be sure you are trying to pop out the right seam.



Every unit is likely wired differently but you should see three wires. A black, one of varying colors, and a white. On our camper... the white wire powered the blue laser light. On all of our light switches, it was the top wire, but I suspect that could vary.

Simply gently pull the white wire. Test the switch. It should still power the lights but not be lit up blue. I then covered the end of the pulled wire with a good wrap of electric tape to prevent any shorts.

Now simply pop switch back into housing and enjoy the darkness.
